A climbing anchor is a system made up of individual anchor points that are linked together to create a master point that the rope and/or climbers clip into to be securely attached to the rock. Whether you're top-rope climbing or lead climbing, knowing how to build a solid anchor is absolutely critical to staying secure.

A natural anchor is a secure natural feature which can serve as a climbing anchor by attaching a sling, lanyard, or cordelette and a carabiner. Examples of natural anchors include trees, boulders, lodged chockstones, horns, icicles, and protrusions. Artificial anchor. TOP-ROPE ANCHORS. Top-rope climbing is one of the safest forms of climbing, where the rope runs from the belayer to the anchor at the top of the route, and then back down to the climber. If the climber falls, a tight belay means that the fall will be kept to a minimum – often only a small amount of rope stretch.

This setup can work for everything from building a climbing anchor to making your own adjustable personal anchor system (PAS). Self-belay loop: Use a 2- to 3-foot length of 5 - 8mm Perlon cord tied in a loop with a double fisherman's knot. This is a good length to make an autoblock hitch or prusik hitch to use as a backup brake while rappelling.
