Shine a light through this vent to locate the manual eject screw. Slide the screwdriver into the vent and turn the screw anti-clockwise until the disc can be seen peeking out of the disc slot. This may require several turns of the screw.

PS4: Eject a stuck disc - PlayStation

If your drive has an emergency eject hole, put the computer to sleep and insert a large, straightened paper clip in the small emergency eject hole of the drive (the location varies, depending on the drive). Push firmly until the disc ejects. Use Open Firmware to eject the disc if all other methods fail (this may not work on all computers).
