Addressing ethical issues in treating client self-injury ...

Screening, assessment, and treatment planning (see Table 1, Key Definitions) constitute three interrelated components of a process that, when properly executed, informs and guides the provision of appropriate, client-centered services to persons with co-occurring disorders (COD).

Screening, Assessment, and Treatment Planning for Persons ...

The use of this tool is described in more detail here: (Validity and reliability of the non-suicidal self-injury assessment test, NSSI-AT) and can be used to assess primary NSSI characteristics, such as form, frequency, and function, as well as secondary characteristics (such as habituation, context in which NSSI is practiced, and perceived life interference, treatment and impact).
