Referencing for Law - Law - LibGuides at Queen's ...

The OSCOLA citation style is a footnote-based format, similar to the Chicago style. However, it is notable for its range of variation, like the Harvard style, and its use of the entire reference as a footnote with the page added at the end.

OSCOLA Citation Style Guide (4th ed.): Referencing ...

- Give the party names, followed by the neutral citation, followed by the Law Reports citation (eg AC, Ch, QB).
- If there is no neutral citation, give the Law Reports citation followed by the court in brackets. If the case is not reported in the Law Reports, cite the All ER or the WLR, or failing that a specialist report.
