37.51.816 YOUTH FOSTER HOMES: SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS AND REQUIREMENTS (1) Each foster child must sleep in a room designated as a bedroom that provides for privacy. (2) Any room in which the child sleeps must have a window sufficiently large for an adult to enter or exit in an emergency. (3) Children of the opposite sex who are five years of age or older must not share a bedroom.
