While GAS is the most common bacterial cause of pharyngitis, acute pharyngitis is most commonly caused by viruses. 1 GAS is the causative organism in 20-30% of cases of pharyngitis, but can increase to 35-50% depending on the population and season. 2,3 Notably, the symptoms of viral and bacterial pharyngitis can be challenging to differentiate.

The most common cause of a sore throat (pharyngitis) is a viral infection, such as a cold or the flu. A sore throat caused by a virus resolves on its own. Strep throat (streptococcal infection), a less common type of sore throat caused by bacteria, requires treatment with antibiotics to prevent complications.

Based on the CDC there are 11,000 to 13,000 cases of streptococcal pharyngitis that arise every year in the United States alone (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention 2018). Each year 20-30% of strep throat cases are found in children and 5-15% of cases are found in adults (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention 2018).
