Basic format for an APA journal citation. The article title appears in plain text and sentence case, while the journal name is italicized and in title case (all major words capitalized). Format. Last name, Initials. (Year). Article title. *Journal Name*, Volume (issue), page range. <https://doi.org/xxxx>. Example.

In-text Citation. Basic Format: Last name, A. A. (Year). Title of article. Title of Journal, Volume number (issue number if available), pages. Example: Scruton, R. (1996). The eclipse of listening. *The New Criterion*, 15(3), 5-13. Note: The name of the author is reversed with the last name first followed by the initials.

APA Journal Citation | APA Format

Use this format to cite the retracted article itself, for example, to discuss the contents of the retracted article. First provide publication details of the original article. Then provide information about the retraction in parentheses, including its year, journal, volume, issue, and page number(s).

Journal Article References - APA Style

If an item has no author, start the citation with the article title. When an article has one to seven authors, all authors' names are cited in the References List entry. When an article has eight or more authors list the first six authors followed by three spaced ellipse points (...), and then the last author's name.

Journal Articles - APA Style (6th Edition) Citation Guide ...

For an APA citation for a journal article with 2 to 20 authors, use a comma between all of the author names. Place an ampersand (&) before the final author's name. For an article with 21 or more authors, list the names of the first 19 authors and use a comma between all of the names.

General Format // Purdue Writing Lab

Include an in-text citation when you refer to, summarize, paraphrase, or quote from another source. For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list. APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005).
