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Common Aqueous Solutions

An aqueous solution is a solution in which the solvent is water. It is mostly shown in chemical equations by appending (aq) to the relevant chemical formula. For example, a solution of table salt, or sodium chloride (NaCl), in water would be represented as $\text{Na}^+ + \text{Cl}^-$ (aq). The word aqueous (which comes from aqua) means pertaining to, related to, similar to, or dissolved in, water.

A common example of a nonelectrolyte is glucose, or $\text{C}_6\text{H}_{12}\text{O}_6$. Glucose (sugar) readily dissolves in water, but because it does not dissociate into ions in solution, it is considered a nonelectrolyte; solutions containing glucose do not, therefore, conduct electricity.

Aqueous Solutions

An aqueous solution is any solution in which water (H_2O) is the solvent.. In a chemical equation, the symbol (aq) follows a species name to indicate that it is in aqueous solution. For example, dissolving salt in water has the chemical reaction:
