Fluid balance chart . The nurses will record the daily inputs and outputs of fluid from a patient. In a nil by mouth (NBM) patient this is particularly important as all fluids must be given IV. ### Fluid Balance Calculation for OSCE - OSCE Trainer

Nursing staff must indicate which patients are on a fluid balance chart. When a patient is transferred verbal and written documentation must include fluid balance and any concerns. Medical staff documentation must include a clear fluid balance management plan. Any patient causing concern must be verbally handed over to next shift. If you are ...

### Rotherham NHS Foundation Trust 24 Hour Adult Fluid Balance ...

Use the chart to record the amount of fluid administered to or taken by a person. If you give a person a drink, accurately record the quantity taken by the individual. You should also record the quantity offered. Record a running total of fluids consumed. For some people, you might need to track fluid intake and output more closely.

It is a chart that documents a patients' water input and output in a 24 hour period. The importance of this is to guide clinical decisions including medication administration and ...

### A Balancing Act: Maintaining accurate fluid balance ...

How frequently the fluid balance chart data should be recorded – such as hourly or two hourly – should be clearly documented. It is not acceptable practice to use shorthand. Fig 3 shows best practice when completing a fluid balance chart and Fig 4 shows an example of unacceptable practice (Smith and Roberts, 2011).

### **Guidelines on correct completion of fluid balance charts ...**

Charts for recording hydration elements such as fluid intake, fluid output, or fluid balance are frequently used with the aim of capturing fluid status and assisting deficit identification.

The Fluid Balance Chart provides a standardised system that is accessible by both nursing staff and Medical Officers to ensure the fluid intake information is up to date. The patients are invited to become involved by keeping track of their oral intake on a simple bedside notecard.

Food chart (if appropriate) Daily: To compare intake with requirements and aid transition between nutrition support and oral intake. Fluid balance charts: Daily in acute setting including fluid delivered by other routes e.g. medications/ IV fluids/ feed flushes and oral fluids. Urine frequency and colour should be monitored in community patients.

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
