American rheumatology traces its origins nine decades back to Europe, when the International Committee on Rheumatism was founded by Jan van Breeman in 1925 at a European meeting of medical hydrology. National committees on rheumatism were established shortly afterward in various European nations; the international committee was soon renamed the Ligue Internationale Contre le Rhumatisme .

The rheumatologists formed the British Society for Rheumatology (BSR), whilst rehabilitation specialists formed the Medical Disability Society (MDS) which later became the British Society of Rehabilitation Medicine (BSRM). The Heberden Society was named after William Heberden (1710-1801), who is considered to be the father of rheumatology.

The first dedicated Rheumatology clinic in Victoria was also started in 1950. In 1951, Dr. Cecil E.
