I need to connect a plastic 110mm waste pipe into a brick manhole. The waste vent runs from your main drain line to prevent back pressure in the main sewer line.This pipe can be interrupted at any point up to 4 feet from the vent shaft that generally exits your home from the roof or the side of the home.
