Go to File > Info > Protect Document > Encrypt with Password. Type a password, then type it again to confirm it. Save the file to make sure the password takes effect. Go to Review > Protect Document. Under Security, you can select whether to enter a password to open the document, modify the document, or both.

Protect a document with a password - Office Support

In an open document, click File > Info > Protect Document. You see the following options. Mark as Final: Make the document read-only. When a document is marked as final, typing, editing, commands, and proofing marks are disabled or turned off and the document becomes read-only.

If you want to prevent people from modifying the document, type a password into the bottom text field on this window.

To apply a password to a document, open the document and click the "File" tab. On the "Info" screen, click the "Protect Document" button and then select "Encrypt with Password" from the drop-down menu. On the "Encrypt Document" dialog box, enter a password and then click "OK." First, go ahead and open the Word document to be protected and head over to the "Review" tab. Next, click the "Restrict Editing" button. The "Restrict Editing" pane will appear on the right side of Word. Here, tick the "Allow only this type of editing in the document" checkbox.
