**How To Tell First Edition**  
First Edition Stated Sometimes the word "First Edition" will helpfully be printed on that page, often described as "First edition stated" by booksellers. "First printing", "First Impression", and "First Published" are other ways of publishers stating the first edition. That bold declaration can't always be taken as authoritative, though.

**How to Identify a First Edition Book - 1st Editions**  
It is a sequence of numbers, usually 1-10, and printed in descending or alternating order. The lowest number found on the page is the print run number. Speaking generally, first editions will hold the most value if they are first editions, first printings.

**How To Tell If A Book Is A First Edition Or Valuable ...**  
The Numbers. A number line is usually present, such as 9 8 7 6 5 4 3 2 1 or 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9. If a 1 is present - in any sequence - it's usually a sign that the book is a first edition. If a book reads something like 3 5 7 9 8 6 4, then your book is not part of the first printing (the example above indicates a third printing cycle).

**How do I tell if my book is a first edition? - Pan Macmillan**  
First Edition Stated. This is perhaps the most straightforward determinant. To make our lives simple, publishers may indicate a first edition, first printing right on the copyright page. Number Lines. These are located on the copyright page. A general rule is that if the number 1 is listed, the book is a first edition.

**How to Identify First Edition Books - Invaluable**  
Beginning in 1929, Funk & Wagnall first editions stated "First published (month, year)" along with the Roman numeral "I" (I) on the copyright page. (Exception: The first edition of John Cheever's The Enormous Radio, published in 1953, has the Roman numeral, but not a first edition statement.)

**First Edition Identification by Publisher**  
Use the number line to determine the printing. The number line near the bottom of the page doesn't necessarily determine the edition, but it tells you how many times the book has been printed. If there is a 1 still present in the number line, it is the first print of the book from the publisher.

General Guidelines for Identifying a First Edition. There are many ways that publishers identify their books as a first edition. Some common ones are: "First Edition," "First Printing," "First Published," "Published," or "First Impression" appears on the copyright page. This 1st Edition Stamp shows this card was from the first release. The king of Pokémon, which some even refer to as the "1952 Mickey Mantle" of the trading card game, is Charizard. Commanding upwards of \$20,000 and beyond, Charizard's value, and that of 1 st Edition cards in general, seems to only increase.

**How to Spot 1st Edition Pokémon Cards From the Rest**  
The publisher may actually state the words 'first edition' or 'first printing' on the copyright page. Another common method of identification is the number line - that's a line of numbers on the copyright page. Usually, if a one is present in the line then it's a first edition. This style has been used since World War II.

To publishers, a first edition is the first version of a book before changes are made (forewords added, afterwords added, typos corrected, whatever requires a new typeset). So, if the publisher prints 5,000 copies of a book, they all sell, and the publisher goes back to print more of the same version of the book?

**Stephen King First Editions: How to Recognize One ...**  
When a book is sold for the first time, that is called the book's "first edition." Quite simply, it is the initial printing of a book (after the book proof/advance copy). Technically the phrase "First Edition" consists of the first printing plus any additional printings of the same first edition.

**How to identify first editions or a first printing of a book?**  
Definition. The definition of a first pressing or pressed vinyl record, is a record that was pressed from the 1st original masters. There seems to be some controversy between record collectors of what is a first pressing as opposed to first issues.

**How Do We Define A First Pressing Or Pressed Vinyl Record ...**  
It also lists the ISBN for the paperback edition (0-590-35342-X). This is the back of the Advance Reader's Edition. It states that the first printing will be 30,000 copies. This is the spine of the Advance Reader's Edition. It has "J.K. ROWLING" just as the first edition does. This is the table of contents from the Advance Reader's Edition.

**First Edition Criteria and Points to identify Harry Potter ...**  
All three of these denote a first edition. The numeral 1 will be removed for a second printing. Black House is the exception. First edition copies state "First Edition" on the copyright page and the number sequence will be "2 4 6 8 9 7 5 3". Trim size is given because Book Club editions are often smaller than trade editions. Also, Book Club edition

**Identifying first editions (updated July 2018) trade**  
In 1922, they began stating "First Edition" as well, but also used the above coding system until 1949. In 1962, they became Harper and Row.They began to use a number line to the bottom of the last page but often failed to remove the "First Edition" statement from later printings.
