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Hrsa Guidelines For Preventive Care

In 2018, the HRSA-supported Women's Preventive Services Initiative released the Well Woman Chart, a resource that includes age-based preventive service recommendations for women from adolescence to maturity. The chart does not include updates to the HRSA-supported comprehensive guidelines, but provides additional clarity for patients and providers, with the goal of improving women's health across the life span.

The HRSA-supported Women's Preventive Services Guidelines were originally established in 2011 based on recommendations from a Department of Health and Human Services' commissioned study by the Institute of Medicine (IOM), now known as the National Academy of Medicine (NAM). Since then, there have been advancements in science and gaps identified in the existing guidelines, including a greater emphasis on practice-based clinical considerations.

The HRSA Guidelines include a recommendation for all FDA-approved contraceptive methods, sterilization procedures, and patient education and counseling for all women with reproductive capacity, as prescribed by a health care provider.

ACA: Preventive Care Coverage Requirements ...

The U.S. Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF) recommends specific screening tests, counseling, immunizations, and preventive medications for a variety of diseases and conditions. 1 For example, annual blood pressure screening is recommended for adults aged 18 and older and annual cholesterol screenings are recommended for adults aged 20 and older with other cardiovascular risk factors.

Preventive Care You and your family may be eligible for some important preventive services at no additional cost to you. If your plan is subject to the new requirements, you may not have to pay a copayment, co-insurance, or deductible to receive recommended preventive health services, such as screenings, vaccinations, and counseling.

The IOM guidelines, which were incorporated into the Health Resources Services Administration's (HRSA) Women's Preventive Services Guidelines, updated in 2016, include contraceptive methods and counseling to include "all Food and Drug Administration-approved contraceptive methods, sterilization procedures, and patient education and counseling for all women with reproductive capacity."

Preventive health care, including counseling, education, and screening, can help prevent or minimize the effects of many serious health conditions. In 2010, 72.3 percent of women reported that they had received a routine checkup or general physical exam that was not for a specific injury, illness, or condition, compared to 63.4 percent of men.
