Every 10 days, Jason-1 measures heights of more than 90% of the world's ice-free oceans with the radar altimeter and completes 127 revolutions, or orbits, around the Earth. To measure sea surface height we need the satellite's position in its orbit and the height between the satellite and the ocean's surface.

NASA has been observing the oceans from space for more than 20 years. NASA launched Seasat, the first civilian oceanographic satellite, on June 28, 1978. The satellite carried five complementary sensors designed to monitor the oceans from space. These sensors included: a radar altimeter to measure spacecraft height above the ocean surface

Measuring Sea-Surface Temperature from Space

The surface of the ocean bulges outward and inward, mimicking the topography of the ocean floor. The bumps, too small to be seen, can be measured by a radar altimeter aboard a satellite. Satellite imagery may also

be used to map features in the water, such as coral reefs.

By subtracting the first distance (between the satellite and ocean surface) from the second distance (between the satellite and Earth's center), we can calculate the distance from the ocean surface to Earth's center.
