Infectious bursal disease is often called Gumboro disease in the United States because it was first identified in the town of Gumboro, Delaware in 1962. IBD is caused by a virus that infects the bursal sac in young chickens. Some strains cause more deaths than others, but chicks seem to be most susceptible at three to six weeks of age.

Species affected: Infectious bronchitis is a disease of chickens only. A similar disease occurs in bobwhite quail (quail bronchitis), but it is caused by a different virus.
