The Charleston Orphan House was established by an ordinance of City Council ratified on 18 October 1790, "for the purpose of supporting and educating poor orphan children, and those of poor, distressed and disabled parents who are unable to support and maintain them." 3 The institution, the first municipal orphanage in the United States, was governed by a board of twelve commissioners or trustees who were annually elected by City Council.
