Italicize the title of a self-contained whole (e.g. a book, film, journal, or website). Use quotation marks around the title if it is part of a larger work (e.g. a chapter of a book, an article in a journal, or a page on a website). All major words in a title are capitalized. When words that would normally be italicized appear within text that is already italicized, those words should be set in standard (nonitalic) type, referred to as reverse italicization. (And, as with italics and quotation marks, titles are not underlined at the head of an essay or article.)

Quotation marks are used to present linguistic examples and titles of book chapters and articles in the text. When writers follow guidelines for the use of italics and quotation marks, their papers become more consistent and readable. Note that this category addresses the use of quotation marks other than in the presentation of direct quotations.

Italics and Quotation Marks - APA Style

The title of a book is in italics. The title of a journal is in italics. The title of a journal article is not in italics or in quotation marks. See the APA Help Guide for examples. Click on References and In-text Citation Examples. In the body of your paper: The name of a journal/magazine article should be in quotation marks.

For example, you may be wondering whether or not you should underline the title of your paper. Essentially, you should not underline your title. Furthermore, your title should not be italicized, nor should there be quotation marks used on either side of your title.

Although the title of a journal article or book chapter is not usually italicized, sometimes words within the title may be italicized. These include book or movie titles, letters or words as linguistic examples, statistics, scientific names for animals , and other items that would be italicized in text, per APA Style guidelines.

The title may contain as many words and characters as the writer needs but the APA format recommends less than 12 words and to avoid using unnecessary information and abbreviations. Everything on the title page should be double-spaced.
